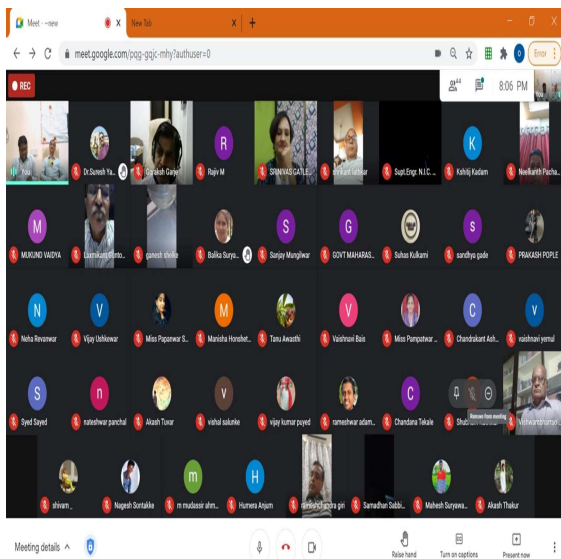

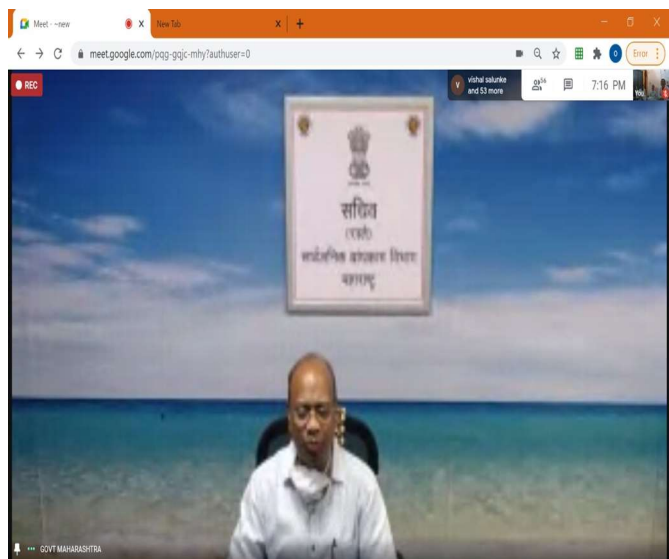

A MIGHTY STEP
Success Story of Govt. Polytechnic Nanded

Ms. Namrata Suresh Panchal is a student from a poor family at Biloli, Dist.Nanded. In the school at Antarbharati Vidyalaya Gandhinagar Biloli, Namrata got 90 % marks in 10th standard. The whole family rejoiced at her resounding success. She is an all-round student who is always appreciated by the teachers for her active participation in oratory competitions and various other activities in the school.

She had a dream of becoming a civil engineer after her matriculation. Some of her teachers confidently gave strength to the wings of her dreams. So she got more energy. But the real obstacle to her dreams was her poor financial situation. To support the family, her father has a small business supplying pure water through a mini filter water plant at Biloli. There are about 5-6 thousand financial receipts per month. Of course, this business is also built through loans. Her father was frustrated despite the desire to repay the loan installments, the downturn due to the lockdown, family responsibilities and the education of other children. Her father somehow admitted her in the 11th science class at a college at Naigson near Biloli, which originally dreamed of becoming a civil engineer, did not appeal to education there. That's how she told her father. Her frustrated father made her aware of her family responsibilities and financial situation and told her to consider engineering education after 12th standard.

Hon'ble Dr. Abhay Wagh, Director, Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra came up with the concept of "School Connect scheme". According to the plan, visits to major schools in the district required to be planned and implemented. The aim of "School Connect scheme" was to provide information about Polytechnic Education especially to the students in rural areas and to identify the need of modern times and to encourage and the inclination of convert students towards Technical Education. Under the guidance of Mr.Mahesh Shivankar Sir, Joint Director of Technical Education, Aurangabad, and Dr. Goraksh Garje Sir, Principal, Government Polytechnic, Nanded, a team was formed to visit various schools in Nanded district. The "School Connect scheme", conceived by Hon'ble Dr.Abhay Wagh sir, was a resurgence of humility and helped to fulfill the dreams of many students like her. Namrata's father was happy to hear that a team from Government Polytechnic Nanded had arrived at Biloli's Antarbharati Vidyalaya. But due to the difficult financial situation, He did not dare to fill up the online form. Deshpande Madam from the same school persuaded Namrata's father the importance of technical education and persuaded him to fill up the online form. Prof. Lokmanwar Sir, Head of Applied Mechanics Dept. and Madhav Hiware Sir, Laboratory Assistant filled the online form of humility. The steps were under taken at Institute level to ensure admission by encouraging aspiring students by forming department wise groups for those who have filled the admission form. Under the guidance of Principal Dr. Goraksh Garje Sir, the work of connecting through mobile started. While

doing this, Prof.P.D.Pople HOD Civil, Prof.S.P. Kulkarni & Mr.B.K.Sarode contacted Namrata's father via mobile. Due to financial difficulties, there was no positive response from her father. Due to the positive assurance given by Prof. SP Kulkarni about the importance of technical education and financial assistance from the department, Namrata's father decided to cancel her admission to the 11th Science at Naigson and decided to come to Government Polytechnic, Nanded.

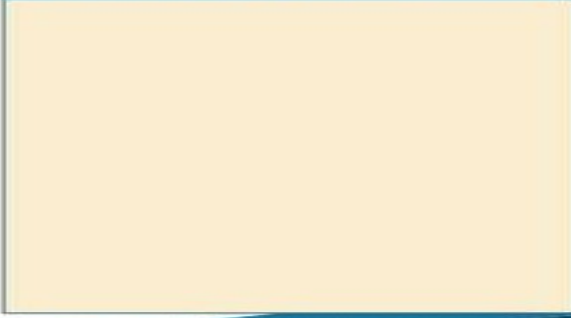
With a view to start positive work in the new year on 1st January 2021, Prof. S.P.Kulkarni requested Prof.P.D.Pople, Head of Civil Dept. to arrange an urgent meeting in this regard for financial help to Namrata. Mr B.K.Sarode Working President of the Laboratory Assistant Association and Laboratory Assistant agreed to pay the full fee of Namrata without any delay and immediately confirmed the admission of Namrata by paying Rs.5000/-.

Prof.P.D.Pople, Prof.S.P.Kulkarni, Prof. Muddassir, Prof. L.T.Jadhav, Prof. S.S.Gade, Prof.V.C.Salanke, Prof. R.V.Adamwad, Prof.Shubham Kathikar provided financial assistance. The department decided to provide uniform, examination fees, all educational stationary requirements and other necessary help.

Through the "School connect scheme" of Hon'ble Director Dr. Abhay Wagh Sir, seeing the tears of humility and joy in the eyes of her father, the dream of the students in the rural areas fulfilled with right spirit. She had all the blessing and support for prosperous and successful future in technical field.
